We wish the best of luck and God's Blessings - to all the children from the parish community who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on May 18th. We are delighted that bishop Doran of Elphin diocese is free to administer the sacrament. Collooney is one of three parishes in this diocese where he is able to honour the time and date originally given by the previous bishop, Bishop Dempsey. We have 78 children for Conformation this year. The church capacity is 306 maximum. Sadly, it is necessary to confine attendance to the child, their sponsor and two parents. This will give us an attendance of 312 on the day. If there are two children from the same family being confirmed, the second child can have two guests in addition to their own sponsor. Thankfully, the ceremony can be live-streamed and, hopefully, provide an opportunity to be watched by all who would like to be present.
