Tax Refund Forms: There are just 3 criteria to be eligible for tax refund on the contributions you make to the parish (which is an eligible charity). You have to be a tax-payer. (PAYE or Self-employed, it doesn't matter) Your total contribution for the year must be €250 or more. You must pay by envelope (so there is a record). The parish will then get back 45% of your total contribution. Note: The CHY3 form covers you for 5 years. If you are eligible and have not yet signed a form, you will have received one in the post with your receipt for 2023. Please return to the Parochial House.
